Place: Assembly Ranch, nine miles west of Lone Pine, Calif.  
Time: Friday, August 11th through Sunday, August 13th.

Accommodations: Accommodations at the ranch are limited. Camping, or campers and trailers, are permitted on the grounds, and regular camp grounds with facilities are in the immediate vicinity. There is a wide choice of good motels and restaurants in town. If you plan on staying at a motel, we suggest you make reservations in advance or have us make them for you.

Transportation: Lone Pine is on U.S. 395, About half way between Los Angeles and Reno, Nevada. There is Greyhound bus service between the two cities with busses from either direction arriving here around 3:00 P.M. Schedule on request.

What to wear: or bring: Except for the sacred service, informal attire is acceptable, with a light sweater or jacket for the late evening, perhaps. Nights are cool. For desert or mountain climbing we suggest shoes that will be a protection against possible snake bites. Don't forget a flash light.

RSVP: Please let us know at least a week ahead, if possible, so that we may plan: 1- when you will arrive; 2- how long you plan to stay; 3- how many in your party; 4- what accommodations you will want; -whether the guest house, if available, or your trailer or camper, camping on the ranch, or something off the grounds, i.e., regular trailer camp or motel; 5- what meals you will eat with us; 6- if and when we are to meet you at the bus or if you will be driving.

Program: For all times except Sunday, program will be open. Suggested activities include listening to taped lectures, discussions, home movies, music, hiking and mountain climbing, reading meditations, classes, working, etc. Sunday sacred service is at 9:45 Pacific standard time, or 10:45 daylight time, at Headquarters House. There will be a free will offering.

Noon dinner will be a smorgasbord with all who can bringing their favorite dish or something appropriate. Two or three kitchens may be available for preparations.

Mid-afternoon will probably be a general discussion on a subject or subjects to be announced.
