1. A fire prevention and control plan adequate in the judgment of the Forest Supervisor to the risks and hazards of this use shall be prepared and placed in effect by the permittee. This plan shall provide for necessary "standby" fire control equipment, an incinerator and for current disposal of trash.
2. Materials of an explosive or inflammable nature shall be stored and handled in a manner satisfactory to the District Ranger.
3. In the event of fire, the permittee shall allow the Forest Service, or other cooperating fire-fighting agencies, to draw upon any or all existing waterlines and reservoirs for water to be used for filling fire trucks or pumping for actual fire-fighting purposes.
4. The permittee agrees to pay the Forest Service, on demand, for damages to timber, young growth, and watershed cover and for all expenses incurred by the United States in suppressing fire caused by the permittee, his agents or employees in the exercise of the privilege granted by this permit.
