

Rules Of The Temple Organization

Each member is expected:

1. To do all in his or her power to promote, by work and act, the Spirit of Harmony and Unity in the Temple.
2. To quietly resign from the organization if dissatisfied from any cause.
3. In the event of withdrawal or resignation from any cause, to return to the Temple Scribe, at Halcyon, Calif., all papers and Teachings marked "Temple Property" or "Private." To provide a proper receptacle in which to keep all papers so marked with directions fixed thereon as follows: "In the event of my death, return these papers to the Temple Scribe, Halcyon, Cal."
4. To pay the required dues of two dollars a year always promptly in advance, either in semi-annual payments of one dollar or annual payments of two dollars on the first of April, or first of October of each year.

NOTE. If the signer of this application be a woman, the title "Miss" or "Mrs." as the case may be, should be prefixed to the name.

Each applicant for membership should be recommended by a Temple member. When this is not possible because of applicant not knowing members, the matter can be arranged by correspondence with the Temple Scribe. The first year's dues of two dollars should accompany this application. Applications and correspondence should be addressed: The Temple of the People, Halcyon, California.

The Temple Artisan will be sent to each new member, as well as the Temple Teachings. Special instructions and explanations regarding same will be sent regularly.
