

"First as to the unfolding of the true principle. The mind has two doors from which issue all its activities. One leads to a realization of the mind's pure essence, the other leads to the differentiations of appearing and disappearing, of life and death. Through each door passes all the mind's conceptions so inter-related that they never have been separated and never will be."

1. There never can be a destruction of either the ponderable or the Substantial orders.
2. In any entity the two orders stand in a state of complete balance.
3. The state of R is exactly balanced by the state of R' in the Unconscious.
4. The mind's conceptions referred to above form the totality of all entities.
5. No entity can be lost for the shrinking of the substantial in the conscious sector is balanced by an equal expansion of the substantial in the unconscious sector.
6. But there is a difference between conscious spirituality and unconscious spirituality.
