

Mathematics of the Infinite and Being.

- I. An elaboration of the idea unfolded last Tuesday.
- II. Thought on objective plane is finite and quantitative.
 - A. We tend to measure achievement by quantity or size.
 1. Actually of no real significance as all size is relative
 2. World of electron a universe as well as the solar system
- III. To exponents of Wisdom Religion achievement is measured in qualitative terms.
 - A. Motive of acts count for more than fine technique.
 - B. Bringing spiritual perception into outer consciousness is what counts.
 1. Numbers not the measure of this.
- IV. The real difference between men is not quantitative but qualitative
 - A. All men are Spiritual Being
 1. Spiritual Being is indivisible, birthless, deathless and changeless.
 2. Impossible for men to be parts of this Being in quantitative sense, without contradiction.
 3. All differentiation qualitative, with equality of all.
- V. Analogue of this found in Mathematics of the Infinite.
 - A. Infinite not quantitatively divisible
 1. Acted upon by any finite number thru any operation remains the same.
 2. Separation into parts of infinite manifolds a qualitative division.
 - a. All parts equal, but qualitatively different.
 - b. Illustration of this point thru discussion of number of infinite manifolds.
- VI. The actually infinite nature of man's consciousness shown in the fact that man can hold any idea as itself the object of idea.
- VII. The work before us that of removing from man the illusion of his finitude, and getting him to recognize himself for what he is, i.e., Infinite Being itself.
