Significance of Death.

- 1. Difficulties involved in problem of death largely grow out of an erroneous statement of the problem.
- 2. Death not a state but a process.
- 3. Life to be regarded as the complex of which Birth and Death are modes.
- 4. Birth and Death the process of Becoming-becoming-not.
- 5. The whole universe of experience is continually transforming yet that transformation des not destroy its Being.
- 6. Fear of death is based upon fear of break in continuity of consciousness.
- 7. Realization that Life is a Fire of continual transformation and that Life is Consciousness removes this fear.
- 8. The concept of Consciousness as a plenum and as focalized and polarized.
- 9. The transformation from polarized to unpolarized Consciousness equivalent to cataclysmic death.
- 10. The fact of altruism is at least evidence of a super-egoic type of Consciousness.
- 11. Knowledge of after-death states of man dependent upon knowledge of constitution of man.
- 12. Reconcilliation of continuity of Life or Consciousness with lamellar organization in states of Consciousness found in taking a non-spacial and Anon-temporal reality and spreading it out in space and time.
